**Market News**

**Beef** – Cattle Pricing in the UK & Ireland has moved up strongly due to concerns over the lack of feed and the increase in wheat pricing. Forequarter cuts are rising in price as the schools return. Imported Beef prices still remain very strong with poor supply.

**UK Topside & Silverside are excellent quality at the moment**

**Lamb** – Live lamb prices are stable, although 25 % more than this time last year New Zealand lamb is still very expensive, though it is still slightly cheaper than UK Lamb.

**British lamb is excellent quality at the moment and eats well**

**Pork** - Pig prices have stalled despite the poor grain harvest impacting feed prices, pork leg, gammon and streaky bacon will rise in price towards the end of the month as demand begins to increase for the festive period.

**Pork Shoulder is excellent value for money and eats well.**

**Poultry** - Poultry prices are rising as again the impact of High feed prices are felt. High demand for breast meat means That this will rise above other cuts.

**Thighs and Legs represent much better value as demand has fallen**
